



FUN IDEAS TO RAISE YOUR SPONSORSHIP FEE!

DIVIDE THE SPONSORSHIP FEE UP!

- 1** Don't ask one person for the full sponsorship fee. Ask several sponsors if they can help you with \$20 or \$30 each. Remember, anyone can be a sponsor, even your parents, grandparents and family friends.

When you ask a company to sponsor you, take your Magazine #1 materials with you. Tell them about your goals and about our website, www.namiss.com. Tell them that they can call our office if they have questions. Be enthusiastic and excited as you talk to sponsors and dress professionally.

- 2** Start with companies your family is familiar with, such as your insurance agent, doctor, dentist, hair dresser, florist, bank or drugstore. Remember, a company sponsorship is a tax deductible advertising expense.

- 3** You do not have to pay all your sponsorship fee at one time. The fee is divided into two payments for you. The first half will be due at your pageant prep. The second half will be due about a month after your pageant prep.

4 SPONSORSHIP FEE TIPS:

HAVE A GARAGE SALE – collect stuff from neighbors on your block and then use the profits for your sponsorship fee. People will love supporting you.

SELL RAFFLE TICKETS – Create a gift basket or have one donated by a business and raffle it off.

HAVE A CAR WASH – Ask a neighborhood business, or organizations such as a church, community center, local grocery store, etc., if you can use their parking area and water. Get a group of your friends to help wash and dry the cars.

HAVE A BAKE SALE – Maybe the same above businesses will allow a bake sale. Bake up a storm and sell the goodies!
